

## 2009 Treasures of Tomorrow Quilt Show Competition Rules

### NEW 2-DAY SHOW AND NEW LOCATION

Oct. 31 and Nov. 1 at the Marshfield Senior High Fieldhouse, 1401 Becker Road Marshfield, WI, 54449

Entry deadline is Thursday 10/15/09.

Completed entry form must be accompanied by a photo of the display item for identification, and the \$5.00 per item entry fee. If for any reason an entry cannot be displayed the entrant will be notified by phone on or before Saturday 10/17/09.

You will receive a one-day show pass with 2 or more quilt entries per person. (Passes will be held at the admission table at the show).

The first 250 entries received will be accepted into the show. Competition is open to anyone living in the Upper Midwest Region

All entries must:

- Fit the definition of quilt; Three layers: backing, batting and top held together by quilting (hand or machine) or tying, and be made of fabric. Be in "show condition", clean and free of stains, smoke or other odors, wear, etc.
- Items previously entered in the Treasures of Tomorrow Quilt Show are not eligible.
- You must include the name(s) of everyone who has worked on the quilt, including name of person who quilted it.
- The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to reject items that are not appropriate or not ready for display and to move entries to correct categories.

All quilts must have a 4" sewn on rod pocket or hanging sleeve. The top edge of the sleeve must be 85" from the bottom edge of the bed quilts. Wall quilts must have a 4" sleeve sewn on the top back of the quilt. Each item must have entrant's name and address on a fabric label SEWN to the lower right back.

Submitted items **MUST** be received in a clear plastic bag. Fold so that the identification label is clearly visible. Use a separate bag for each item entered. Items may not be returned in original bag.

### DROP-OFF INSTRUCTIONS

Entries must be dropped off on Friday, 10/23, between the hours of 3:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. and Saturday, 10/24, between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and Noon at Wesley United Methodist Church at 205 E 3rd, Marshfield (corner of 3rd and Maple). Entrants will be issued a claim check card for each item entered when the items are dropped off.

Claim check cards must be presented when picking up the item after the show on Sunday Nov. 1

### SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

Send shipped entries to Sew Smart Quilt Shop and Sewing Center, 125 S Central, Marshfield, WI, 54449. Entries can be received no sooner than 10/19/09 or no later than 10/24/09. Entrant is responsible for shipping and insurance costs to and from Sew Smart Quilt Shop. If item is to be shipped back to you, you must include a prepaid, self-addressed shipping label from the shipper of your choice. If this label does not accompany your quilt or if the amount is not sufficient, this will delay the return of your quilt. Do not send cash.

Claim check card will be sent upon arrival of shipped entry

### PICK-UP INSTRUCTIONS

Entries must be picked up at Marshfield High School between 3:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, November 1st.

**REMINDER!** Claim check cards must be presented when picking up entries.

Security will be provided, however, items entered are at your own risk. Check with your homeowners insurance.
